TIPS FOR MEMORIZING SCRIPTURE

- 1. Start with passages you may already be familiar with.
- 2. Read the verse through several times aloud, thoughtfully dwelling on each word and phrase.
- 3. Write the verse on an index card to carry around with you all the time.
- 4. Tape your verse to the bathroom mirror and work on it during your morning routine.
- 5. Write out the verse while saying it out loud slowly.
- 6. Write the first letter of each word in the verse as a cheat sheet instead of referencing the full verse when you get stuck.
- 7. Test your memorization with a friend while you recite it from memory without looking.
- 8. Spend time memorizing when you first wake up and right before you go to sleep.
- 9. Use the verse in prayer to God.
- 10. Repeat, repeat, repeat.
